REPORT

Gopala Krishna Murthy, Professor and Principal, Bapatla College of Pharmacy, Dr. G. Kishore Babu, Head, Formulation and Application, Laila Nutraceuticals, Mr. Satheesh S. Gottipati, Associate Professor, Dept. of Pharmacy Practice, Dr. P. Srinivasa Babu Professor and Principal, Dr. P. Sowjanya, IQAC Coordinator, Professor and Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Biotechnology, Dr. Afzal Basha Shaik, Professor and Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Dr. Ch. V. Prasada Rao, Professor and Head Dept. of Pharmacy Practice and Mr. G. Yalamandeswara Rao, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Science and Humanities contributed shared their knowledge and skills.

Inaugural Session

Program had two sessions every day. Session was inaugurated with the Opening Remarks of Dr.P. Sowjanya, IQAC Coordinator, Welcome Address by Professor and Principal Dr. P. Srinivasa Babu. Pre-Program talk was given by Dr. Afzal Basha Shaik on the flow chart of the sessions going to be held and motivated faculty members to participate in the sessions. Day wise report of FIP is given below.

Day 1 – 15.07.2019 (Monday)

SESSION: I

Speaker: Dr. T.E.G.K. Murthy, Professor and Principal, Bapatla College of Pharmacy, Bapatla.

Topic: Teaching Learning Styles & Techniques



Speaker of the session initiated his speech by briefing out the learning styles of students. It was suggested to focus more on Student Centric rather than traditional teaching. He also informed to faculty members we should always suggest students to make them learn in a way they prefer. It was also suggested to stick on to different learning

contemporary styles for the benefit of the students and faculty. Session came to an end with the closing remarks of Mrs. Srividya Assistant Professor.

SESSION: II

Speaker: Dr. G. Sai Kishore, Associate Professor, Bapatla College of Pharmacy, Bapatla.

Topic: Design effective lab activities/ tasks for deep learning

Speaker in his session deliberated that the necessity of making lab live and active. He motivated faculty to have an opinion that lab is the place where we explore our quest for knowledge and research. Deep learning enhances students as it paves way for active learning and hence it's important to design lab activities for students. It is mandatory to design the same with learning outcomes.



Day 2 – (16.07.2019)

SESSION: I

Speaker: Mr. Satheesh S. Gottipati, Dean-Academics PharmD, Associate Professor

Topic: Scope of Pharmacy Education in India.

Speaker of the session deliberated that Pharmacy education in India traditionally has been industry and product oriented. In contrast to the situation in developed nations, graduate pharmacists prefer placements in the pharmaceutical industry. To practice as a pharmacist in India, one needs at least a diploma in pharmacy, which is awarded after only 2 years and 3 months of pharmacy studies. These diploma-trained pharmacists are the mainstay of pharmacy practice. In India, there has been a surge in the number of institutions offering pharmacy degrees at various levels and a practice-based doctor of pharmacy (PharmD) degree program was started in some private institutions in 2008. He also stressed that we should adhere to the changing face of the profession is discussed, including the establishment of the PharmD program. The session was concluded with the end note that Pharmacy professionals should always be ready with the notion that always expect the unexpected.



SESSION: II

Speaker: Dr. P. Srinivasa Babu Professor and Principal, Vignan Pharmacy College.

Topic: Teaching Learning Process in line with OBE.

Session was initiated with the light on what an Outcome-Based Education (OBE) is? As it is a student-centric learning model that helps teachers to plan the course delivery and assessment with the end point in mind. Let me provide an example to make it simpler. For example: He insisted us to keep in mind about the end point (outcomes) when he/she designs the curriculum (while planning lessons, designing assignment & assessments, lecturing and other activities). Everything a teacher does in the classroom should ultimately lead the student toward the outcomes of the course. He added that every institution will have a different way of doing OBE process. He stressed on few parameters that you must be aware in order to measure Outcome-Based Education are



- ✓ Graduate Attributes (GA)
- ✓ Program Educational Objectives (PEO)
- ✓ Program Outcomes (PO)
- ✓ Course Outcome (CO)

Day 3 – 17.07.2019 (Wednesday)**SESSION: I**

Speaker: Dr. P. Sowjanya, Professor and Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Biotechnology, IQAC Coordinator.

Topic: Bloom's Taxonomy: Application in Framing Questions



Speaker of the session deliberated the necessity of introducing new steps in designing examination paper to ensure that the student is tested for the different cognitive levels of learning. Blooms Taxonomy named after Benjamin Bloom classifies the different layers of learning processes that a student goes through when the learning objectives are set for them in a teaching. She added in her session Blooms Taxonomy system has enabled the teachers to set examination

papers that are well balanced, testing the different cognitive skills without a tilt towards a tough or easy paper perception. Session came to an end with Q & A session.

SESSION:II

Speaker: Dr. Afzal Basha Shaik, Professor and Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Chemistry.

Topic: Research and Professional Development.

Speaker motivated students on the importance of publication, research and ethics of publishing. He informed that academic publication involves many synchronized steps and procedures – proper study design, executing the same, collection of data, analysis, and at last publication. In the process of publication what is most expected is the experience which gives us patience. He also explained briefly about the ethics one should follow for publication. It was also explained about the essentiality of Plagiarism. It was also informed about the research integrity everyone should follow. He also explained that once if we started adhering to the ethics and integrity it would be very easy to publish papers. After a brainstorming discussion the session came to an end.



Day 4 – 18.07.2019 (Thursday)

SESSION:I

Speaker: Dr. Ch. V. Prasada Rao, Professor and Head, Dept. of Pharmacy Practice.

Topic: Values, Ethics and Environmental Consciousness.

Speaker of the session insisted on the essentials of being environmental consciousness as it is the first ethics for a pharmacist. He stressed on the importance of maintaining a harmonious relationship with all the species around the college and he also emphasized to enjoy the nature around the institution by not disturbing it. He stressed the young faculty minds to abide by the moral principles for the better future. Session came to an end with Q&A session.



SESSION:II

Speaker: Mr. G. Yalamandeswara Rao, Assistant Professor, Dept. of S & H.

Topic: Using ICT to deeper learning ICT in education.



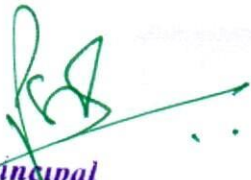
Speaker of the session emphasized that the impact of ICT on learning and teaching would help to foster digital India. The research found that there is no direct relationship between the computer usage of students and their perceived impact of ICT on learning. Usage of ICT for learning and teaching purposes are statistically-significant and positively-related to their perceived impact. However, the relationship between ICT skills and their perceived impact of ICT on learning was comparatively more significant for teachers as it aids in spending quality time. Further the speaker insisted that the more ICT teaching process the more navigation towards learning skills successfully. Sessions came to an end with the closing remarks of member secretary.
