Report - Orientation Session on National Education Policy (with focus on Innovation and Entrepreneurship)

Institution Innovation Council (IIC) of Vignan Pharmacy College, Vadlamudi organized Orientation Session on "National Education Policy (with focus on Innovation and Entrepreneurship)" on 19th February, 2021. The main objective of the session was to create awareness on newly launched National Education Policy – 2020. Dr. P. Sowjanya, Organizing Secretary started the session by welcoming the participants. The key note speaker of the session was Dr. D. V. Rama Koti Reddy, Executive Director, AP State Skill Development Corporation, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh. Dr. D. V. Rama Koti Reddy shared the vision for Higher Education in India – 2020 with a focus on three main elements i.e. Students enrolling in the Higher Education System Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education and Educational Technology, and Online Education. He also shed light on the current state of the Learning Crisis, which gave way to the creation of this new structure i.e., it replaced the 10+2 with 4+3+3+2+3.

The substantial impetus placed on vocational education or hands-on learning in the new policy will give rise to multiple hybrid jobs. With the rapid progression of information technology, and to be able to offer the students a much broader, multidisciplinary foundation, he expressed the importance of using a holistic and multidisciplinary learning approach which will help the learners adapt and reinvent themselves to the demands of the new hybrid work culture and dynamic socio-cultural changes.

The flexibility and autonomy now presented to the future workforce will enable them to explore a variety of options and build more relevant and in-demand skills rather than following traditional career paths. However, implementing it includes more mentoring and ground work. If implemented effectively this will lead to a flexible learning ecosystem.

Mr. A. Viswanath, President of IIC addressed that though the challenges are complex and expectations are high with the well-intended approach and commitment we can reform the education field. Dr. P. Ravi Sankar, Convener of IIC stated that with a clear focus on equality, choice based credits and innovational educative aspects NEP-2020 focuses to transform India as a "Knowledge hub". Day 1 – 12.10.2020 (Monday)

SESSION: I

Topic: Student to Teacher Transformation.

It involves a series of transitions, which are rarely linear or smooth, from one situation to another. Day 2 – 13.10.2020 (Tuesday)

SESSION-I

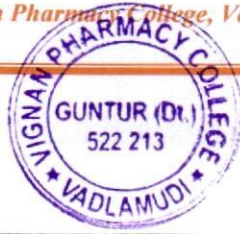


SESSION: II

Topic: Innovative Pedagogies

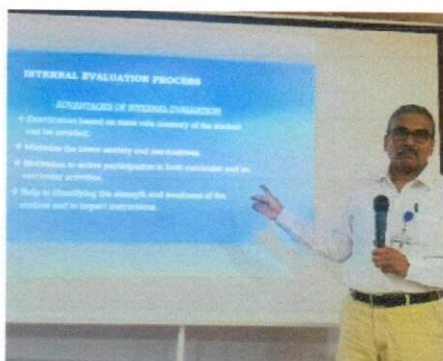

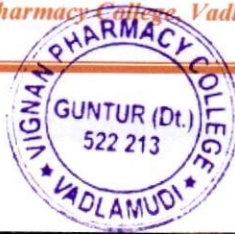
SESSION: II

Speaker: Dr. Ch. V. Prasada Rao, Professor & Head, Dept. of Pharmacy Practice.

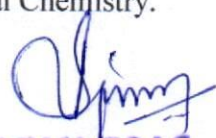
Topic: Mentoring
